When you host a Quarterly Meeting with NCEJN, we provide:

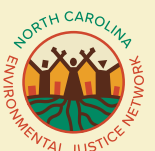
Logistical Support to help you organize the meeting, including venue selection, coordination, and communication

Event: Water Walk and Strategy Meeting

For our first quarterly meeting of 2024, we witnessed and discussed local fossil fuel expansion projects, including Buc-ee's, Mountain Valley Pipeline (MVP), MVP Southgate, and the Moriah LNG Facility with 7 Directions of Service

Number of Attendees: 53

Outcome: NCEJN raised funds for an 8,000-word investigative report on Buc-ee's which will be available in April 2025

QM3: Rocky Mount, September 1, 2024
Host: El Futuro Es Nuestro
Event: Worker Vigil and Heat Stress Strategy Meeting

Our third quarterly meeting of 2024 brought together a coalition of farmworkers, union workers, advocates, and community leaders to address the life-threatening impacts of extreme heat and workplace abuses, foster solidarity, document injustices, and strategize for systemic change

Number of Attendees: 75

Outcome: Increased strategic collaboration between workers facing workplace injustices in NC
